3-D Printers

What if you owned a machine that could make almost anything you wanted? That's the idea behind 3-D printers. You enter a pattern into the printer, and it manufactures the item for you, usually out of plastic. So far, these printers are mostly used by businesses rather than consumers. One reason is that they're still quite expensive, with the best ones costing thousands of dollars. Another disadvantage is that you often need some advanced software skills to make complicated items. You have to be able to make an accurate design for the computer to print.

But 3-D printers are slowly getting cheaper and more-user friendly for **ordinary** people. There are small, affordable ones made for children, which can print simple toys. Home printers that cost under \$1000 can also make small items for the home—for instance, cups or flower pots. Professional designers are uploading and sharing their designs online. Then beginners can download and use them for free. And some companies have built home 3-D printers that can use metal or stone, and not just plastic. If 3-D printers keep becoming more practical, there will soon be one in every home.
